Student Scholarship Program 2018



Details of the Scholarship:

The Beaudesert State High School Parents & Citizens Association is offering scholarships to Year 7 students attending Beaudesert SHS in 2018. These are offered for **Academic, Sporting,** and **Cultural** prowess.

A maximum of three scholarships in each field may be offered this school year. The scholarship consists of:

- Full remission of Student Resource Scheme contribution for one calendar year subject to quarterly reviews.
- Provision of one school shirt and shorts (at no cost).

Duration:

Scholarships shall be held for one year.

Responsibilities of Scholarship Holders:

<u>All</u> scholarship holders have the responsibility to maintain an "A" rating in both Behaviour and Effort across all subjects at all reporting junctures. In addition:

- Academic scholarship holders must maintain at least 5 "A" ratings from 6 subjects in achievement at all reporting junctures.
- Sporting scholarship holders must maintain an achievement rating of 'A' in Health and Physical Education and achievement ratings higher than or equal to a "B" in all other subjects at all reporting junctures and:
 - Represent the school in at least one inter-school sporting team
 - Participate in all school sporting carnivals
 - Strive to represent the school at zone level or higher in at least one sporting discipline.
- **Cultural** scholarship holders must maintain an achievement rating of 'A' in The Arts and achievement ratings higher than or equal to a "B" in all other subjects at all reporting junctures and:
 - Represent the school in at least one of school band, debating, cheer leading, Rock Eisteddfod etc.
 - Participate in all relevant school cultural activities.

Application Process

Students applying for the scholarship must complete the application form and return it with references by Friday 10th November 2017 to:

Appraisement and Notification of Scholarships

Selection of successful candidates will be determined by the Principal and another senior member of staff.

Applicants will be notified of the success or otherwise of their applications by mail by late November.

Principals of primary schools will be notified in writing of the status of their students' applications at the same time.

The scholarship program at Beaudesert State High School is provided to students through community support of the school. Successful applicants will be required to honour our donors and contribute through exemplary attendance, industry and behaviour in all they do. A commitment to the school's co-curricular program is essential. Parents of applicants will also have a role to play.

The Principal will review the scholarship on a quarterly basis dependent on each student's contribution to the school community.
